No lumber, drywall, siding, roofing material, etc. Empty or dried up latex paint cans are ok, but not oil-based paint. No electronics or hazardous material. Please ask if you are not sure. Thanks in advance for keeping our neighborhood clean.

#### Join Citizens on Patrol Walks

Citizens on Patrol (COP) are neighbors who volunteer their time to patrol Ridgely's Delight. They act like the eyes and ears for the local Southern District Police. The visibility of these groups in the neighborhood is the best deterrent of crime because it shows that we look out for each other. There are two organized groups that walk the neighborhood on Sunday and Monday evenings for about one hour. It is not mandatory that you walk every week so you can join whenever you are free.
